## Scams, Cons and Deals A Consumer Affairs Investigator's View of the World

The Calabasas Chamber's August 26th Luncheon will be held at the Calabasas Inn starting at 11:30 a.m. with featured speaker **Rigoberto Reyes, Supervising Investigator from the Los Angeles Department of Consumer Affairs.** Rigoberto will help the Chamber members protect themselves as individuals and as business owners. Topics to be covered at the luncheon will be **Privacy Protection, Identity Theft, Fraud Prevention and Senior Abuse.** Rigoberto has a wealth of knowledge in these fields and will discuss some of the current scams going on and how we as individuals and business owners can protect ourselves from fraud.

Rigoberto has worked for the department for almost 9 years. In his capacity with the department, he has supervised the proper resolution of over 3,200 formal consumer complaints filed with the department every year involving a variety of issues, including credit disputes, automobile sales, retail sales and contracts, landlord-tenant disputes, immigration consultants and paralegal, and identity theft. Many of these complaints result in special investigations, which are prosecuted by city, county, and state prosecuting agencies.

**City of Calabasas – Sign Code Amendment** – On August 12th, the Planning Commission is scheduled to review the final draft of amendments to the City of Calabasas Signage Code before it moves on to City Council on September 1st. The document contains improvements to the City sign code based on comments and suggestions made by the public, a Council appointed special task force and prior reviews by the Planning Commission and City

Council. A copy of the document will be posted on the agenda for upcoming meetings.

**City of Calabasas – Rental Registration Ordinance** – On June 23rd, new Rental Registration Rules were adopted by the Council for the City of Calabasas. The purpose of the ordinance is to assist the City in obtaining an inventory of rental units, their location and rental rates. The Registration program requires

owners of properties with four or more rental units to register their units with the City within 30 days, and to notify the City of any changes in ownership or rental increases. Copies of the ordinance are posted on the City of Calabasas website: [www.cityofcalabasas.com](http://www.cityofcalabasas.com).

**AB 2832** – Among other provisions, this bill seeks an increase in the state minimum wage to \$7.25 in 2005 and to \$7.75 in 2006. If passed, it will make California's minimum wage the highest in the nation. Opposition to the bill, which has included some chambers of commerce, has contended that passage will have a negative impact on California's recovering economy by, among other things, causing businesses to cut jobs and move out of state to avoid the high costs. Generally, Republicans in the Legislature have opposed it and Democrats have supported it. **Proposition 72** – This proposition addresses increases in health care costs for businesses and is opposed by the California Chamber of Commerce.
