## California's Paid Family Leave

The Governmental Affairs Committee of the Calabasas Chamber of Commerce at its August committee meeting heard guest speaker Laura Plotkin, District Director for State Senator Sheila Kuehl, give an overview of the Paid Family Leave insurance program. Please visit the EDD website ([www.edd.ca.gov](http://www.edd.ca.gov)) for further information on Eligibility, Cost, Relation of the Paid Family Leave insurance program to the Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA) and the California Family Rights Act (CFRA), Benefits and Claim Form.

**Paid Family Leave insurance program:** Senate Bill 1661, signed by the Governor in 2002, created the Paid Family Leave insurance program to provide for six weeks of benefits to workers who take time off to:

- Care for a seriously ill child, spouse, parent, or domestic partner.

- Bond with a new child due to birth, adoption, or foster care placement.

Paid Family Leave insurance applies to all employees covered by State Disability Insurance (SDI) (including elective coverage.) For more information, please call 1-877-BE-THERE.

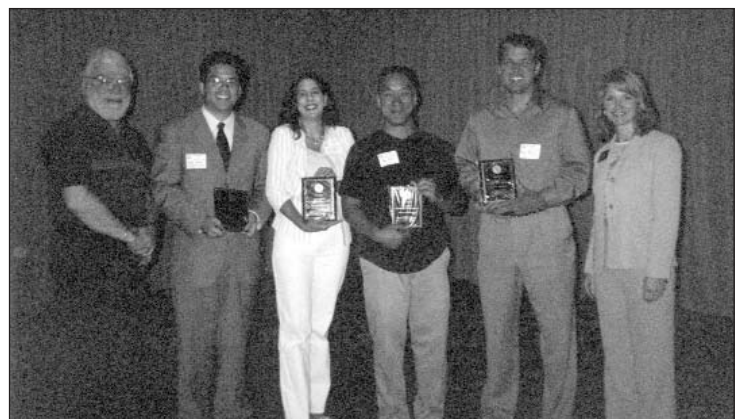
